Reflect on the impermanence and fragility of life and remind

ourselves that sometimes people die tragically before their time.

Consider our own mortality, value our own lives and resolve to use our time wisely.

Reflect on what lives after us and remind ourselves that on the one hand we are but dust and ashes, but on the other hand, we are children of God created in the image of God.
