## **Operation Isaiah**

Each year, our congregation participates with congregations throughout the country in a program called Operation Isaiah. This program is in response to the words of the Prophet Isaiah that is part of the Haftarah on Yom Kippur.

Is this the fast I desire,
A day for men to starve their bodies?
No, this is the fast I desire:
To unlock the fetters of wickedness and
Untie the cords of the yoke to let the
Oppressed go free;
It is to share your bread with the hungry,
and to take the wretched into your home...
(When) you offer your compassion to the
Hungry and satisfy the hungry creature...
Then shall your light shine
In the darkness,
And your gloom shall be like noonday.

Bring more meaning to your fast this year by giving food that you might have eaten on Yom Kippur to someone who has little or no food to eat. As Yom Kippur approaches, let our ears and hearts be open to hearing and acting upon the sacred words of our prophets.

Bring your grocery bag filled with non-perishable food and other items as suggested below to the synagogue during the week between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. We will deliver the collected food to the Five Towns Kosher Food Pantry after the holiday.

## **Sisterhood Social Action Project:**



The Crayon Initiative was born one night when Bryan Ware and his family went out for dinner. While his boys sat coloring on the menu, Bryan couldn't help but wonder where restaurant crayons end up, when all the people go home.

Turns out, it's the landfill—making a big waxy mess that never biodegrades. Why, Bryan thought, couldn't they be re-purposed to create more joy in the world? He took the crayons home and got busy—figuring out the art of collecting and sorting old crayons, melting them down, and remanufacturing them in a bright, clean, paper-free form. Consulting an occupational therapist, he even gave his new crayons a unique design—large and three-sided, not round—so they're easy for kids to grip and can't roll off hospital trays.

Finally, he crafted a network for sending free crayons to over 797,200 kids in hospitals all over the country. Today The Crayon Initiative partners with over 240 hospitals including St. Mary's Healthcare System, NYU Winthrop Hospital Children's Medical Center, Cohen Children's Medical Center and New York-Presbyterian Komansky Children's Medical Center.


