THE MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2026 WILL BE FOR THE CASTING OF PROXY VOTES IN-PERSON AND THE TALLYING OF ALL VOTES CAST.

This is a Directed Proxy and may be used to establish a quorum and to authorize my proxy to exercise the entire vote of the undersigned only as directed below. (The member should complete their vote choice before naming a proxy or submitting the form themselves.) **If a Family Membership, both adults may vote.**

The vote is on the sale of 49-10 Little Neck Parkway to NY Pillar Church for the sum of \$5,400,000 and on the use of the NET proceeds from the sale to Merge with Temple Israel of Great Neck. The details of the sale and merger are contained in the Contract of Sale and Rider and Merger Plan and Restated Bylaws respectively, sent to all eligible members in advance of this vote.

These actions are structured as a single, unified plan requiring a two-thirds affirmative vote of members in good standing that vote.

An affirmative (YES) vote is in favor of the sale and merger and authorizes the President to execute the Contract of Sale and Rider and Merger Plan. It also authorizes a joint Petition of Merger with TIGN to the New York State Supreme Court requesting an Order confirming the Merger together with approval of the Sale of the synagogue building to NY Pillar Church.

A negative (NO) vote is opposed to the sale and/or merger and leaves the fate of the Congregation uncertain.
